Rules for Singles match

<PST-1>

Qualifying round: It is a block league match with 3 players in each group. The match format is 8 Game Pro-set match.

Main round: The top 1st and 2nd place winners from each qualifying block league will play in the main round. All 3rd place participants will play in the consolation. The format of the main round is the best of 3 sets match (in case the set count is 1-1, the third set will be a 10-point match tiebreak). The consolation matches will be 8 Game Pro -set match.

<PST-2>

Qualifying round: It is a block league match with 4 players in each group. The match format is 8 Game Pro Set match.

Main round: The top 1st and 2nd place winners from each qualifying block league will play in the main round. All 3rd and 4th place participants will play in the consolation. The format of the main round is the best of 3 sets match (in case the set count is 1-1, the third set will be a 10-point match tiebreak). The consolation matches will be 8 Game Pro -set match.

<PST-3>

Qualifying round: It is a block league match with 3 players in each group. The match format is 8 Game Pro-set match.

Main round: The top 1st and 2nd place winners from each qualifying block league will play in the main round. All 3rd place participants will play in the consolation. The format of the main round is the best of 3 sets match (in case the set count is 1-1, the third set will be a 10-point match tiebreak). The consolation matches will be 8 Game Pro -set match.

<PST-4>

Qualifying round: None

Main round: It is a league match with 3 players. The format of the main round is the best of 3 sets match (in case the set count is 1-1, the third set will be a 10-point super tiebreak). As it is a league match format, there will be no consolation matches.

<PST-5>

Qualifying round: None

Main round: It is a league match with 5 players. The format of the main round is 8 Game Pro-set match. As it is a league match format, there will be no consolation matches.

*What is the 8 Game Pro-set match "

The 8 Game Pro -set match is the player wins the game by taking 8 games with two-game differences. If the game count reaches 7-7, two more games are played to determine the winner at 9-7. If the game count reaches 8-8, a 7-point tiebreak is applied next. If the score reaches 6-6, the tiebreak continues until taking 2-point difference.

Rules for Doubles match

<PST-1+2 mix>

Qualifying round: Numbers 1 and 2, 3 and 4, and 5 and 6 will each draw lots to determine their block. It is a block league match with 3 pairs in 1 group. The match format is 6 Game Pro-set match.

Main round: A draw will be conducted based on the results of the qualifiers to determine the matchups. The match format is 6 Game Pro-set match for both the main round and the consolation. Only the final match of the main round is 8 Game Pro-set match. If the seeded pair loses game in the first round, they will not play in the consolation.

<PST-3+4+5 mix>

Qualifying round: It is a block league match with 3 pairs in 1 group. The match format is 6 Game Pro-set match.

Main round: A draw will be conducted based on the results of the qualifiers to determine the matchups. The match format is 6 Game Pro-set match for both the main round and the consolation. Only the final match of the main round is 8 Game Pro-set match. If the seeded pair loses game in the first round, they will not play in the consolation.

*What is the 6 Game Pro- set match"

The 6 Game Pro-set match is the player wins the game by taking 6 games with two game differences . If the game count reaches 5-5 , two more games are played to determine the winner at 7-5 . If the game count reaches 6-6 , a 7-point tiebreak is applied next . If the score reaches 6-6, the tiebreak continues until taking 2-point difference .

Judging Method

Self-judging is applied. The server should announce the score in a voice that the receiver can hear before serving. If the players cannot distinguish whether the ball is in or out in their own court, they should make a judgment in favor of the opponent. Judging calls should be made promptly using a voice that the opponent can hear and hand signals that the opponent can see. For players who have difficulty with self-judging or calling points due to disabilities (such as vision impairment or hearing loss), line judge assistance or point call assistance may be provided to ensure a fair match.

Notes

- The match will proceed with the order of play posted on the bulletin board in front of the competition headquarters (Tournament Desk) .
- If called by the competition headquarters before the match, both players must go to the headquarters to receive the scorecard and the ball.
- At the start of the match , wait in the designated court for the competition staff to arrive . When the staff arrives at the court , player will hand over the scorecard to the staff . The staff will look at the scorecard , confirm the players , toss a coin , and specify the match method and the color of the letters on the court-side scoreboard.. After that , a 5-minute practice will take place before starting the match . Do not practice before the staff arrives .
- If delayed by more than 10 minutes after the match starts, the match will be considered forfeited.
- No breaks are allowed during the end change after the first game and during the tiebreak .
- After the match , record the score on the scorecard , and both players must sign to confirm . The winner will take the scorecard and ball to the competition headquarters .
- MTO (medical timeout) is basically one per body part per match, within 3 minutes, but may be extended if approved by the Competition Headquarters.
- MT (medical treatment) is basically within 90 seconds before a change of ends or 120 seconds before a set break, but may be extended if approved by the Competition Headquarters.
- If any trouble occurs during the match, be sure to call a competition headquarters staff member and have them deal with the matter.
- Do not allow people outside the court to interfere with your self-judging.
- Additionally , to ensure a smooth progression of the match , please follow the instructions of the competition staff .

Meals and Water Supply

The event organizers will provide lunch for the players and staff . It will be distributed at the designated location with the announced time . If you have dietary restrictions due to health reasons , please prepare your own meals . There will be no designated break for lunch , so everyone should eat during your own available time . Please sort and dispose of waste in the designated areas .
